KEYNOTE SPEAKER: KRIS M. MARKMAN, PH.D., HARVARD LIBRARIES

Kris M. Markman is a communication scholar with more than 20 years experience in higher education including teaching, program administration, management, and research. She currently serves as the Director of Organizational Learning for the Harvard Library, where she is launching a comprehensive learning and professional development program for an organization of more than 730 staff. In 2015 she co-founded the User Research Center at Harvard Library, the University's premier lab for user-centered design, digital accessibility, and testing, where she also studied students' research and information behaviors. Prior to coming to Harvard in 2014, Markman was an Assistant Professor of Communication and the Program Coordinator for the online BA in Communication Studies at the University of Memphis. She has also held teaching appointments at Northeastern University, Bridgewater State University, Austin Community College, and Odessa College.

Markman's research has appeared in Computers in Human Behavior,

the Journal of Language & Social Psychology, New Media & Society, the Journal of Business Communication, and the Journal of Radio & Audio Media, as well as in several edited volumes. Her most recent project focuses on the relationship between teaching and professional and organizational identity among librarians. She holds a Ph.D. in Communication Studies from The University of Texas at Austin, and an MA in Media Communications Management from Webster University.
